Dear Parent/Guardian,

Sixth Form Off-Site Policy 2018-2019

As you are aware, we operate an off-site policy in the sixth form: this allows students to leave the site when they are not required for a timetabled lesson, study period or activity. This enables students who prefer to work independently to continue their studies at home or carry out research based work. This provision relies on the students being responsible for themselves when not in registered school activities. All year 13 students should be in morning registration or as arranged, however, should we find that students are not completing their studies or not using this provision appropriately we may decide to allocate more supervised study sessions or withdraw the off-site provision for these students. Following a successful probation, Y13 students will be able to arrange not to attend a maximum of two registration periods.

I would be grateful if you could complete the attached reply slip to confirm that you are aware of this policy and consent to your son/daughter leaving the school site.
