## COURSES FOLLOWED

Students will study 3 A level subjects with the option to study the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ).

Students will study the equivalent of three level 3 qualifications which will be a mixture of $A$ level courses and/or a practical/vocational course.

Students will study the equivalent of three courses at level 3.

These courses are equivalent to GCSE grade 4 and are vocational or practical. They can be preparation for level 3 courses, apprenticeships or work. Mathematics and English will be studied if students have not achieved a GCSE grade 4.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

7 GCSEs to include at least five at grade 5 or above including English and Mathematics.
Some courses require subject specific entry criteria, which are detailed in the individual course listings.

7 GCSEs to include at least five at grade 4 or above including English and Mathematics.
Some courses require subject specific entry criteria, which are detailed in the individual course listings.

5 grade 4s or above at GCSE or equivalent, at least grade 4 in GCSE English and/or Mathematics.

An interest in the chosen course. All students who do not have a grade 4 or above in GCSE English and/or Mathematics will study these subjects at an appropriate level.

In addition to the above entry requirements, the following specific GCSE results are usually required for each subject:

| Business \& Enterprise BTEC Level 3 | Minimum of Grade 4 in Maths due to there being a mandatory finance module. |
| Chemistry A Level | Grade 6-6 or above in Combined Sciences or Grade 6 or above in Chemistry. |
| Computer Science A Level | Minimum of Grade 5 in GCSE Maths. |
| Construction \& the Built Environment | Five GCSEs. |
| Criminology BTEC Level 3 | Grade 5 in English, Maths and a Science. |
| Digital Media Production BTEC Level 3 | Five GCSEs at G4 including English Language. |
| English Literature A Level | Grade 7 in GCSE English Language or English Literature. |
| Esports BTEC Level 3 | Five GCSEs including English Language and Maths. |
| Further Mathematics A Level | Grade 8 in GCSE Maths plus an extreme confidence with the GCSE higher tier course as it forms the basis of the Year 12 course. |
| Geography A Level | Grade 6 in GCSE Geography. |
| Health \& Social Care BTEC Level 3 | Grade 4 in GCSE English and Maths. You are not required to have studied H\&SC previously. |
| Law BTEC Level 3 | Five GCSEs including English Language and a Humanities subject. |
| Mathematics A Level | Grade 7 in GCSE Maths, plus an extreme confidence with the GCSE higher tier course as it forms the basis of the Year 12 course. |
| Music Performance BTEC Level 3 | Music BTEC Level 2 at Grade Merit or above or Music GCSE Grade 4. |
| Photography A Level | GCSE Art Grade 6 or above. If you have not studied photography at GCSE then you must submit a portfolio of work for consideration. |
| Psychology BTEC Level 3 | Minimum of Grade 5 or above in English Language, Maths and a Science. |
| Sociology A Level | Grade 5 in GCSE English and Maths and a Humanities subject. |
| Sport BTEC Level 3 | GCSE PE Grade 5 or Merit level at BTEC First. Due to the nature of the assessment, a Grade 5 in GCSE English Language is essential. |
| Travel \& Tourism BTEC Level 3 | Grade 4 in GCSE English and Maths. You are not required to have studied T\&T previously. |
