Digital Media Production BTEC Level 3	Five GCSEs at G4 including English Language.
English Literature A Level	Grade 7 in GCSE English Language or English Literature.
Esports BTEC Level 3	Five GCSEs including English Language and Maths.
Further Mathematics A Level	Grade 8 in GCSE Maths plus an extreme confidence with the GCSE higher tier course as it forms th basis of the Year 12 course.

Sociology A Level	Grade 5 in GCSE English and Maths and a Humanities subject.
Sport BTEC Level 3	GCSE PE Grade 5 or Merit level at BTEC First. Due to the nature of the assessment, a Grade 5 in
Travel & Tourism BTEC Level 3	GCSE English Language is essential. Grade 4 in GCSE English and Maths. You are not required to have studied T&T previously.
